Develop your academic language skills, learn more about living and studying in Australia and meet other UQ international students.

If you have been accepted into a UQ degree program and already meet the minimum English language entry requirements, you are eligible to join ESP:ACS.

This three-week, pre-semester English language course is provided at no additional charge for all new international students enrolled at UQ.

Course Content

ESP:ACS is designed and delivered by UQ's Institute of Continuing & TESOL Education (ICTE-UQ).

It provides UQ international students with the specialist language and academic skills needed to succeed in their studies and is highly recommended for all students from non-English speaking backgrounds.

Course content will provide you with an opportunity to:

- understand and take notes in academic lectures
- prepare and deliver academic presentations
- write cohesive academic essays and research reports
- efficiently read academic texts
- express ideas clearly and comprehensively
- actively contribute to academic discussion
- develop the critical thinking ability to enable you to process the content of your university studies
- become aware of the expectations of the Australian academic community
- revise the everyday English language skills needed to live and communicate in Australia.

ESP:ACS also includes an orientation to Australia, its history and environment and gives you important extra time to settle in to life in Australia before you start your university studies.

Course Dates

ESP:ACS courses run for three weeks prior to Orientation each UQ semester.

Semester 2 2010:	28 June - 16 July

ESP:ACS is delivered on the UQ St Lucia campus and the UQ Ipswich campus (subject to demand).
